

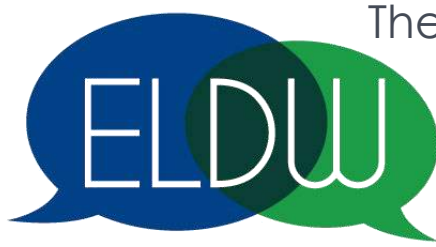

Kyiv is the city of the thriving local democracy

This year from September 9th until October 15th, the European Local Democracy Week celebrates its 10th anniversary. For this special occasion the city of Kyiv filed for participation in The “European Local Democracy Week” and is willing to obtain the “**12 Star**” label – the highest award from the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe.



The main theme of the ELDW in 2017 is
“**Citizen participation, consultation and
commitment: for a thriving local
democracy**” that is close and relevant

European Local Democracy Week for the capital of Ukraine, because in recent years the city authorities are confidently taking the course of development and promotion of the citizen participation tools in the decision-making process.

In particular, Kyiv actively implements the Public Budget and significant changes have been made to the parameters of the Public Budget 2018. In conjunction with the public, we have developed a new more effective provision for

reviewing and realization of electronic petitions – one of the most effective tool for direct electronic democracy that is leading in Kyiv among all of the Ukrainian cities. In addition, we have improved local initiatives regulations. Kyiv city authorities have worked out and submitted for consideration to the plenary meeting of the Kyiv city council the regulations on the general meeting of the members of the territorial community of the city of Kyiv. There was also initiated the introduction of improving of the procedure for public hearings and the procedure for granting permissions for the creation of bodies of self-organization of the population, etc.

For this reason, Kyiv city council aiming at attracting Kyiv residents to participate in important decision-making processes in the social, cultural, economic and political life of the capital initiated the holding of events in the framework of ELDW 2017, which attracted a large number of Kyivans and guests of the city.



Image and promotional campaign of the ELDW 2017




For a large, interesting and useful European Local Democracy Week in Kyiv, an Action Plan has been developed for a diverse target audience, mainly for the youth - students, active young people. However, different events were available for all the citizen groups, for all the

planned activities were open and accessible.

In order to inform the citizens about ELDW and its events, the city authorities launched image and promotional campaign using graphic visuals provided by the Congress. Banners, booklets, press walls, notebooks, city-lights, etc. were developed, adapted and manufactured.



Announcement and publicity of the events within the framework of the Week was carried out on the official web-portal of the Kyiv city council, Kyiv city state administration, sub-web portals of the departments of the executive body of the Kyiv city council (Kyiv city state administration), district state administrations of the city of Kyiv, in local media , as well as in the social network Facebook. In addition, a separate website with a detailed programme of the ELDW activities was developed and published, for the convenience of the level of activities it was structured to the city and district activities, and an interactive calendar of events was created.

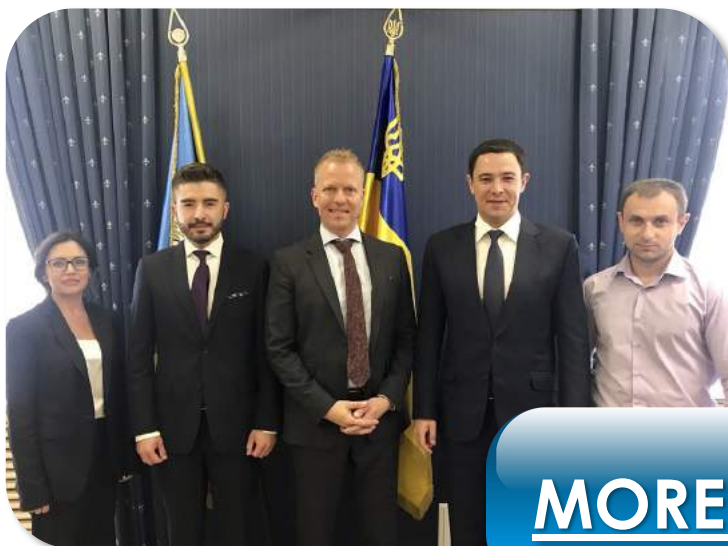


ELDW all over the city

The most significant activities of the ELDW were as follows

KYIV INVESTMENT FORUM



Kyiv Investment Forum is an outstanding international event that became a discussion and presentation platform for the municipal authorities and business community to discuss joint projects and attract investments.

In order to raise awareness of citizens about the local activities, to intensify the promotion processes on the principles and achievements of the local democracy in Ukraine and Europe, during the Kyiv Investment Forum on September 26, 2017, the informational corner of the European Local Democracy Week was located. In front of the ELWD promotional banner, the relative leaflets were handing out. The ELDW logo was printed and published in the handouts of the forum (notebooks, forum programmes, and press-walls).

WORLD CULTURE FESTIVAL

On October 7, in the hall of Kyiv city council the World Culture Festival took place, 35 embassies of foreign states and 23 ambassadors introduced to the guests their traditions, folklore, national cuisine, literature and everyday life.

Within the framework of the event, around 8000 visitors could get acquainted with the cultural peculiarities of Australia, Argentina, Azerbaijan, Bulgaria, Armenia, Ghana, Guinea, Greece, Egypt, Uzbekistan, Moldova, Germany, Korea, Iraq, Iran, Romania, Slovenia, Kazakhstan, India, Turkey etc.

For significant achievements in the categories "Social Initiatives", "Initiatives for the improvement", "Educational Initiatives", "Cultural Initiatives", "Sport Initiatives", "Educational Initiatives", 21 civil society organizations were awarded by the Kyiv city Mayor awards.
